Summary of Legislation: This bill provides that a library board may charge a reduced fee or not charge a fee for a local library card that is issued to an Indiana resident who is not a resident of the library district but is: (1) enrolled in a nonpublic school that is located in the library district; or (2) a home schooled resident of the county where the library district is located. (Current law makes this provision for students of public school corporations that are located at least in part in the library district.)

Explanation of Local Revenues: This bill provides that a library board of a Class 2 public library **may** charge a reduced fee or not charge a fee for a local library card that is issued to an Indiana resident who is not a resident of the library district but is: (1) enrolled in a nonpublic school that is located in the library district; or (2) a home schooled resident of the county where the library district is located. There are 4 Class 2 public libraries in the state. This bill could reduce the amount of revenue generated from fees charged for a library card by a Class 2 public library. The fiscal impact is dependent on local action.
