Summary of Legislation: Defines "source of radiation". Requires the state department of health to adopt rules requiring inspections of radiation machines and other sources of radiation by qualified technical personnel who are knowledgeable in the discovery of radiation area incongruities, have at least five years experience in the discovery or control of radiation regulatory noncompliance, and hold certification by the Nuclear Medicine Technology Certification Board. (Current law requires the state department of health to adopt rules regarding inspection of radiation machines, but does not specify who is qualified to make those inspections.)
