Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill extends the Northwest Indiana Commuter Rail and Transportation Study Commission through November 1, 2001. It provides for the appointment of a vice chairperson. The bill adds the study of high speed rail service to the responsibilities of the Commission.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Study commissions have been allocated \$9,000 per year for their work during the last several biennia. Their expenses are paid from appropriations to the Legislative Council. The fund affected is the State General Fund.
