Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill excludes a person who fills or gauges the product level of an underground storage tank from the definition of operator for purposes of underground storage tanks corrective actions.

Effective Date: (Amended) Upon passage.

Explanation of State Expenditures: This bill eliminates a category of potential responsible parties for helping fund a corrective action. If no liable parties are found, the costs for the cleanup is paid by available money in the Underground Petroleum Storage Tank Trust Fund. The Fund is used to pay costs associated with corrective actions resulting from leaks from underground petroleum storage tanks.
