Summary of Legislation: This bill requires that a member of the university faculty, chosen from a list provided by a search and screen committee, be appointed by the governor to the Ball State University board of trustees for a two year term.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Trustees are paid a per diem for board meetings, commencement exercises and other designated university events, a mileage allowance, lodging expenses, education and training, and communication and administrative expenses. These expenses average \$3,350 per trustee in a given year. Consequently, the additional annual cost to Ball State University to add one trustee would be \$3,350 and could be covered under their existing budget.
