Summary of Legislation: (Amended) (A) This bill provides that a resolution passed by a county fiscal body to approve a distribution to a solid waste management district under the laws concerning the county option income tax and the county adjusted gross income tax may: (1) expire on a date specified in the resolution; or (2) remain in effect until the county fiscal body revokes or rescinds the resolution.

(B) It prohibits districts from adopting or enforcing a resolution or ordinance establishing permits or licenses for: (1) siting or operation of a solid waste management facility not owned by the district; or (2) the collection and transportation of solid waste.

(C) It provides that the law restricting the provision of waste management services by districts does not apply to activities conducted as part of household hazardous waste collection and disposal projects. It allows a district to address multiple one day events in one resolution that allows the district to provide waste management services if the events all take place in the same year.
