IMPACT: State

Summary of Legislation: This bill exempts an individual who held a Commercial Driver's License before April 1, 1992, and who is engaged only in intrastate commerce from federal requirements for minimum distant binocular visual acuity.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: This bill will have no fiscal impact on expenditures for the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV)

Explanation of State Revenues: It is difficult to estimate the fiscal impact regarding the issuance of Commercial Drivers Licenses (CDLs). It is possible, that because of the provisions of this bill, additional persons would be issued a CDL that might otherwise not be eligible for such a license. A four-year CDL is \$26, with \$15 deposited in the Motor Vehicle Highway Account and \$11 deposited in the State License Branch Fund.
