Summary of Legislation: This bill establishes the Community Mobilization Matching Grant program for the promotion of various child welfare issues. The bill appropriates \$2,500,000 for the period beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000, and \$2,500,000 for the period beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001, to carry out the program.

Effective Date: July 1, 1999.

Explanation of State Expenditures: This bill appropriates \$2.5 million for each of the next two years to the Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) to implement the Community Mobilization Matching Grant program. The purpose of the grant program is to provide a two year grant in each participating county to implement or expand one of the goals listed in the bill. Participation in the program by a county is voluntary. Proposals from local communities must be submitted to the county step ahead council and the step ahead council shall select one application for submission to the FSSA. The FSSA will award the grants.
