Summary of Legislation: This bill removes references to the New Castle State Developmental Center and the Northern Indiana State Developmental Center. The bill relocates provisions within the Indiana Code governing the Family Support Program and the funding requirements for Centers for Independent Living. The bill also requires that a majority of the members appointed to the Family Support Council must approve any action. It revises the duties of the Bureau of Developmental Disabilities Services. This bill requires the Bureau to provide service coordination services to developmentally disabled individuals. The bill authorizes the adult protective services unit to use the prosecuting attorney to obtain a protective order. It also requires the Board of Interpreter Standards to adopt certain rules. The bill removes the Director of the Division of Family and Children's authority over state owned children's facilities. It adds two members to the Interagency Coordinating Council. The bill removes the State Fire Marshal's Office from the community residential facilities council. It makes numerous changes to transition services offered to disabled students who leave the special education program. It repeals existing provisions governing community residential programs, case management services, respite care, diagnostic assessment, rehabilitation services, the emergency support fund, and the family subsidy program. The bill makes conforming amendments.
