Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill provides that for changes to occur in zoning in west Clay Township in Hamilton County, the legislative body approving the changes must include members appointed by the elected officials of Clay Township.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: (Revised) This bill provides that certain zoning actions taken by the Carmel City Council must include members appointed by the elected officials of Clay Township, Hamilton County. The bill does not specify whether the newly appointed members receive a salary or any type of reimbursement when serving on the city council for specific zoning actions. In 1998 a Carmel City Council member received an annual salary of \$3,865.
