Summary of Legislation: This bill establishes the State Mandates Oversight Committee. The Committee has legislative and citizen members. The Committee is required to review legislation enacted by the General Assembly to determine whether the legislation imposes an unfunded mandate on local government. The Committee may recommend that legislation that imposes an unfunded mandate on local government be repealed or amended or that the General Assembly provide the necessary funding for the mandate.

Effective Date: Upon passage.

Explanation of State Expenditures: This bill creates the State Mandates Oversight Committee which consists of eight legislative members and 5 lay members. Each member is entitled to per diem, mileage, and travel allowance. Legislative Council Resolution 1-98 allows for a budget of \$9,000 for an interim study committee. This bill is effective upon passage. If the newly established committee meets prior to June 30, 1999, there would be expenditures in FY 1999.

The Legislative Services Agency is required to provide staff and administrative services for the Committee.
