# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

**MR. SPEAKER:**

I move that Senate Bill 55 be amended to read as follows:

1           Page 3, between lines 40 and 41, begin a new paragraph  
2           and insert:  
3           "SECTION 3. IC 7.1-3-16.5-5 IS AMENDED TO READ  
4           AS FOLLOWS[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 5 The holder  
5           of a supplemental retailer's permit shall be entitled to purchase  
6           alcoholic beverages only from a permittee entitled to sell to him  
7           under this title. A supplemental retailer shall be entitled to  
8           possess and sell only those types of alcoholic beverages which  
9           he may lawfully possess and sell under his beer retailer's, liquor  
10          retailer's, wine retailer's permit, or small winery permit, that  
11          qualifies him to hold a supplemental retailer's permit. A  
12          supplemental retailer shall be entitled to sell the appropriate  
13          alcoholic beverages at retail for on the licensed premises  
14          consumption only on Sunday as provided in IC 7.1-3-1-14. The  
15          holder of a supplemental retailer's permit shall not be entitled  
16          to sell alcoholic beverages at wholesale, nor for carryout or  
17          at-home delivery. However, the holder of both a small winery  
18          permit and supplemental retailer's permit is entitled to sell wine  
19          as authorized under IC 7.1-3-12-5 for carryout on Sunday **and**  
20          **the holder of both a brewer's permit and a supplemental**  
21          **retailer's permit is entitled to sell beer manufactured under**  
22          **IC 7.1-3-2-7 for carryout on Sunday.**
