# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 31 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 3, line 18, delete "or".
- 2 Page 3, line 20, delete "." and insert "; or".
- 3 Page 3, between lines 20 and 21, begin a new line double block
- 4 indented and insert:
- 5 **"(DD) IC 9-18-47 (Indiana AFL-CIO trust license plates)."**
- 6 Page 12, between lines 29 and 30, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 7 "SECTION 18. IC 9-18-47 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 8 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 9 JANUARY 1, 2001]:
- 10 **Chapter 47. Indiana AFL-CIO Trust License Plates**
- 11 **Sec. 1. The bureau of motor vehicles shall design and issue an**
- 12 **Indiana American Federation of Labor-Congress of Industrial**
- 13 **Organizations license plate, to be known as the Indiana AFL-CIO**
- 14 **trust license plate. The Indiana AFL-CIO trust license plate shall**
- 15 **be designed and issued as a special group recognition license plate**
- 16 **under IC 9-18-25.**
- 17 **Sec. 2. After December 31, 2000, a person who is eligible to**
- 18 **register a vehicle under this title is eligible to receive an Indiana**
- 19 **AFL-CIO trust license plate under this chapter upon doing the**
- 20 **following:**
- 21 **(1) Completing an application for an Indiana AFL-CIO trust**
- 22 **license plate.**
- 23 **(2) Paying the fees under section 3 of this chapter.**
- 24 **Sec. 3. (a) The fees for an Indiana AFL-CIO trust license plate**

- 1 are as follows:
- 2 (1) The appropriate fee under IC 9-29-5-38(a).
- 3 (2) An annual fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25).
- 4 (b) The annual fee referred to in subsection (a)(2) shall be
- 5 collected by the bureau.
- 6 (c) The annual fee described in subsection (a)(2) shall be
- 7 deposited in the fund established by section 4 of this chapter.
- 8 **Sec. 4. (a) The Indiana AFL-CIO trust fund is established.**
- 9 (b) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not
- 10 currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same
- 11 manner as other public trust funds are invested. Interest that
- 12 accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.
- 13 (c) The commissioner shall administer the fund. Expenses of
- 14 administering the fund shall be paid from money in the fund.
- 15 (d) On June 30 of each year, the commissioner shall distribute
- 16 the money from the fund to the general fund of the Indiana
- 17 AFL-CIO, a labor organization under Section 501 (c)(5) of the
- 18 Internal Revenue Code.
- 19 (e) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not
- 20 revert to the state general fund."
- 21 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
