MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 166 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 8, between lines 15 and 16, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 4. IC 20-14-3-10 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 10. (a) The library
- 4 board shall determine the rate of taxation for the library district that is
- 5 necessary for the proper operation of the library. The library board shall
- 6 certify the rate to the county auditor, and the county auditor shall
- 7 certify the tax rate to the county tax adjustment board in the manner
- 8 provided in IC 6-1.1. An additional rate may be levied under section
- 9 8(5) of this chapter.
- 10 (b) If the library board fails to:
- 11 (1) give published notice to its taxpayers of its proposed budget
- 12 and tax levy for the ensuing year at least twenty-one (21) days
- 13 before the second Monday in September; or
- 14 (2) finally adopt the budget and fix the tax levy at least two (2)
- 15 days before the second Monday in September;
- 16 then the last preceding annual appropriation made for the public library
- 17 is renewed for the ensuing year, and the last preceding annual tax levy
- 18 is continued. In this case, the treasurer of the library board shall report
- 19 the continued tax levy to the county auditor, no later than two (2) days
- 20 before the second Monday in September.
- 21 (c) **Notwithstanding any other provision, if a library board**
- 22 **proposes to increase the library district's property tax rate, the**
- 23 **library board must submit its proposed property tax rate increase**
- 24 **to the city or town fiscal body, if the library district is located only**

1 **within a city or town, or to the county fiscal body, if the library**
2 **district is not located only within a city or town. The proposed**
3 **property tax rate increase must be submitted at least fourteen (14)**
4 **days before the fiscal body is required to hold budget approval**
5 **hearings. The library board may not increase the library district's**
6 **property tax rate unless the increase is approved by the fiscal**
7 **body."**

8 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
