I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 294 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Delete the title and insert the following:
- 2 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state
- 3 administration.
- 4 Page 3, between lines 15 and 16, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 5 **"(j) The attorney general may, in the attorney general's**
- 6 **discretion, issue an official opinion at the request of a permit**
- 7 **holder regarding whether a particular person has an interest in the**
- 8 **permit holder under this section. If the attorney general issues an**
- 9 **opinion under this subsection, the following may rely on any**
- 10 **conclusions of the attorney general's opinion for purposes of this**
- 11 **section:**
- 12 (1) **The permit holder.**
- 13 (2) **Any person identified in the request for the opinion.**
- 14 (3) **Any candidate.**
- 15 (4) **Any committee.**
- 16 (5) **The commission."**
- 17 Page 8, between lines 19 and 20, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 18 **"(l) The attorney general may, in the attorney general's**
- 19 **discretion, issue an official opinion at the request of a permit**
- 20 **holder regarding whether a particular person has an interest in the**
- 21 **permit holder under this section. If the attorney general issues an**
- 22 **opinion under this subsection, the following may rely on any**
- 23 **conclusions of the attorney general's opinion for purposes of this**
- 24 **section:**

- 1           **(1) The permit holder.**
- 2           **(2) Any person identified in the request for the opinion.**
- 3           **(3) Any candidate.**
- 4           **(4) Any committee.**
- 5           **(5) The commission."**
