MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 506 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 18, between lines 38 and 39, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 12. IC 25-23.6-8.5-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 3. An applicant under
- 4 section 1 of this chapter must complete the following educational
- 5 requirements:
- 6 (1) Complete sixty (60) semester hours of graduate coursework in
- 7 counseling that must include either a master's degree ~~that~~
- 8 ~~required not less than forty-eight (48) semester hours~~ or a doctor's
- 9 degree in counseling **from an accredited institution.** The
- 10 graduate coursework must include the following content areas:
- 11 (A) Human growth and development.
- 12 (B) Social and cultural foundations of counseling.
- 13 (C) Helping relationship, including counseling theory and
- 14 practice.
- 15 (D) Group dynamics, processes, counseling, and consultation.
- 16 (E) Lifestyle and career development.
- 17 (F) Assessment and appraisal of individuals.
- 18 (G) Research and program evaluation.
- 19 (H) Professional orientation and ethics.
- 20 (I) Foundations of mental health counseling.
- 21 (J) Contextual dimensions of mental health counseling.
- 22 (K) Knowledge and skills for the practice of mental health
- 23 counseling and psychotherapy.
- 24 (L) Clinical instruction.

1 (2) Not less than one (1) supervised clinical practicum, internship,
2 or field experience in a counseling setting, which must include a
3 minimum of one thousand (1,000) clock hours consisting of one
4 (1) practicum of one hundred (100) hours, one (1) internship of
5 six hundred (600) hours, and one (1) advanced internship of three
6 hundred (300) hours with at least one hundred (100) hours of face
7 to face supervision. This requirement may be met by a supervised
8 practice experience that took place away from an institution of
9 higher education but that is certified by an official of the
10 institution of higher education as being equivalent to a clinical
11 mental health graduate level practicum or internship program at
12 an institution accredited by an accrediting agency approved by the
13 United States Department of Education or the Association of
14 Universities and Colleges of Canada. "

15 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
