MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1005 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 48, delete lines 31 through 42.
- 2 Page 49, delete lines 1 through 16, begin a new paragraph and
- 3 insert:
- 4 "SECTION 44. IC 6-1.1-28-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 5 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 1. Each county
- 6 shall have a county property tax assessment board of appeals composed
- 7 of individuals who are at least eighteen (18) years of age and
- 8 knowledgeable in the valuation of property. ~~The fiscal body of the~~
- 9 ~~county shall appoint two (2) individuals to the board. At least one (1)~~
- 10 ~~of the members appointed by the county fiscal body must be a certified~~
- 11 ~~level two assessor-appraiser.~~ The board of commissioners of the county
- 12 shall appoint ~~two (2)~~ **three (3)** freehold members so that not more than
- 13 three (3) of the five (5) members may be of the same political party and
- 14 so that at least three (3) of the five (5) members are residents of the
- 15 county. ~~At least one (1) of the members appointed by the board of~~
- 16 ~~county commissioners must be a certified level two assessor-appraiser.~~
- 17 A person appointed to a property tax assessment board of appeals may
- 18 not serve on the property tax assessment board of appeals of another
- 19 county at the same time. ~~The members of the board shall elect a~~
- 20 ~~president.~~ The employees of the county assessor shall provide
- 21 administrative support to the property tax assessment board of appeals.
- 22 The county assessor is a voting member of the property tax assessment
- 23 board of appeals and shall serve as ~~secretary~~ **president** of the board.
- 24 **The county auditor or the county auditor's designee is a voting**

1 **member of the board and shall serve as secretary of the board.** The
2 secretary shall keep full and accurate minutes of the proceedings of the
3 board. A majority of the board constitutes a quorum for the transaction
4 of business. Any question properly before the board may be decided by
5 the agreement of a majority of the whole board."
6 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
