# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1050 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 3, between lines 30 and 31, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 2. IC 20-10.1-16-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 8. (a) The state
- 4 superintendent shall develop an ISTEP program testing schedule in
- 5 which:
- 6 (1) each student in grades 3, 6, **and 8 and 10** must be tested; and
- 7 (2) each **high school** student must ~~take~~ **be tested by taking** a
- 8 graduation examination.
- 9 (b) A student who is a child with a disability (as defined in
- 10 IC 20-1-6-1) shall be tested under this chapter with appropriate
- 11 accommodations in testing materials and procedures unless the
- 12 individuals who develop the child's individualized education program
- 13 determine that testing under this chapter, or a part of the testing, is not
- 14 appropriate for the student and that an alternate assessment will be
- 15 used to test the student's achievement.
- 16 (c) Any decision with regard to a student who is a child with a
- 17 disability (as defined in IC 20-1-6-1) to participate in testing under this
- 18 chapter, to receive accommodations in testing materials and ~~procedure,~~
- 19 **procedures**, to participate in remediation under IC 20-10.1-17, or to be
- 20 retained at the same grade level for consecutive school years shall be
- 21 made in accordance with the child's individualized education program,
- 22 subject to the ISTEP program manual, and federal law."
- 23 Page 4, line 24, strike "determine the appropriate".
- 24 Page 4, line 25, strike "grade during which a student may" and insert

- 1 **"adopt rules to establish when a high school student is eligible to".**
- 2 Page 4, line 26, strike "The grade established under this subsection
- 3 must be".
- 4 Page 4, strike line 27.
- 5 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
