I move that House Bill 1172 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, line 9, after "(4), and" insert "**five**".
- 2 Page 16, after line 33, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 20. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999] (a) **The Indiana**
- 4 **state board of education and the professional standards board shall**
- 5 **jointly develop and report to the general assembly by January 1,**
- 6 **2000, a plan to reimplement the "Academic Study of Religion in**
- 7 **Secondary Schools", which was implemented in Indiana in 1978,**
- 8 **1979, and 1980. The plan must do the following:**
- 9 (1) **Address the following:**
- 10 (A) **The training of prospective and current teachers.**
- 11 (B) **Curriculum guidelines.**
- 12 (C) **Teacher training materials.**
- 13 (D) **Student learning materials.**
- 14 (E) **Costs.**
- 15 (2) **Follow guidelines established or implied by the United**
- 16 **States Supreme Court on the teaching of religion in public**
- 17 **schools.**
- 18 (3) **Encourage variety in course programming such as**
- 19 **providing for courses to be offered as:**
- 20 (A) **self-contained units within language arts, fine arts,**
- 21 **or social studies curricula; or**
- 22 (B) **part of an integrated program in humanities studies.**
- 23 (4) **To assure constitutional application, address the need for**
- 24 **teacher consultation and professional oversight and review**

1           **to answer questions of interpretation and application.**  
2           **(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2001."**
