# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1458 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert the following:
- 2 SECTION 1. IC 6-9-2.5-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 7. (a) The county
- 4 treasurer shall establish a convention and visitor promotion fund.
- 5 (b) He shall deposit the following in the convention and visitor
- 6 promotion fund:
- 7 (1) All of the money received under section 6 of this chapter, if
- 8 the rate set under section 6 of this chapter is not greater than ~~two~~
- 9 **three percent (2%): (3%)**.
- 10 (2) The amount of money received under section 6 of this chapter
- 11 that is generated by a ~~two~~ **three percent (2%) (3%)** rate, if the
- 12 rate set under section 6 of this chapter is at least ~~two~~ **three**
- 13 **percent (2%): (3%)**.
- 14 (c) Money in this fund shall be expended only as provided in this
- 15 chapter. **That portion of the money in the fund that is generated by**
- 16 **a one percent (1%) rate must be expended for the operating**
- 17 **expenses of a convention center.**
- 18 (d) The commission may transfer money in the convention and
- 19 visitor promotion fund to any Indiana nonprofit corporation for the
- 20 purpose of promotion and encouragement in the county of conventions,
- 21 trade shows, visitors, or special events. The commission may transfer
- 22 money under this section only after approving the transfer. Transfers
- 23 shall be made quarterly or less frequently under this section.
- 24 (e) **Any structure constructed or remodeled with money from**

1 **the convention and visitor promotion fund must be open to the**  
 2 **public.**

3 SECTION 2. IC 6-9-2.5-7.5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
 4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 7.5. (a) The county  
 5 treasurer shall establish a tourism capital improvement fund.

6 (b) If the rate set under section 6 of this chapter is greater than ~~two~~  
 7 **three percent (2%); (3%)**, the county treasurer shall deposit in the  
 8 tourism capital improvement fund an amount equal to the money  
 9 received under section 6 of this chapter minus the amount generated by  
 10 a ~~two~~ **three percent (2%) (3%)** rate.

11 (c) The commission may transfer money in the tourism capital  
 12 improvement fund to:

13 (1) the county government, a city government, or a separate body  
 14 corporate and politic in a county described in section 1 of this  
 15 chapter; or

16 (2) any Indiana nonprofit corporation;  
 17 for the purpose of making capital improvements in the county that  
 18 promote conventions, tourism, or recreation. The commission may  
 19 transfer money under this section only after approving the transfer.  
 20 Transfers shall be made quarterly or less frequently under this section.

21 **(d) Any structure constructed or remodeled with money from**  
 22 **the tourism capital improvement fund must be open to the public.**
