# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1902 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 3, after line 41, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 3. IC 20-8.1-6.1-13 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 3. (a) If a student:
- 4 (1) has legal settlement in the attendance area of a school
- 5 corporation in another state, when legal settlement is determined
- 6 without regard to the appointment of a guardian in Indiana solely
- 7 for the purpose of facilitating the placement of the student in a
- 8 facility described in subdivision (2);
- 9 (2) is placed in a state licensed private or public health care
- 10 facility, private or public child care institution, or treatment center
- 11 in Indiana by:
- 12 (A) the parent or guardian of the student; or
- 13 (B) a governmental entity in another state; and
- 14 (3) is enrolled in a school corporation in Indiana;
- 15 the state licensed private or public health care facility, private or public
- 16 child care institution, or treatment center where the student is placed,
- 17 regardless of when the student is placed, is jointly liable with the
- 18 person placing the student for transfer tuition under this chapter.
- 19 (b) **Notwithstanding subsection (a), a sole proprietorship, a**
- 20 **partnership, an association, a corporation, a limited liability**
- 21 **company, a fiduciary, an individual who is not the student's parent,**
- 22 **or another entity in Indiana that accepts the placement of a student**
- 23 **who:**
- 24 (1) has legal settlement in the attendance area of a school

1           **corporation in another state; and**  
2           **(2) is enrolled in a school corporation in Indiana;**  
3           **is liable in full for the student's transfer tuition under this chapter.**  
4           **The Indiana state board of education shall hear all appeals under**  
5           **this subsection in accordance with section 10 of this chapter."**
