# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1996 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 9, line 9, after "fireworks" insert ";".
- 2 Page 10, line 12, strike "(c)".
- 3 Page 12, before line 1, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 4 "SECTION 6. IC 22-11-14-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 5 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 8. (a) A person
- 6 shall not sell at retail, or offer for sale at retail, any fireworks, novelties,
- 7 or trick noisemakers other than the following:
- 8 (1) Dipped sticks or wire sparklers. However, total pyrotechnic
- 9 composition may not exceed one hundred (100) grams per item.
- 10 Devices containing chlorate or perchlorate salts may not exceed
- 11 five (5) grams in total composition per item.
- 12 (2) Cylindrical fountains.
- 13 (3) Cone fountains.
- 14 (4) Illuminating torches.
- 15 (5) Wheels.
- 16 (6) Ground spinners.
- 17 (7) Flitter sparklers.
- 18 (8) Snakes or glow worms.
- 19 (9) Smoke devices.
- 20 (10) Trick noisemakers, which include:
- 21 (A) Party poppers.
- 22 (B) Booby traps.
- 23 (C) Snappers.

- 1 (D) Trick matches.
- 2 (E) Cigarette loads.
- 3 (F) Auto burglar alarms.
- 4 **(11) Chasers.**
- 5 **(12) Firecrackers.**
- 6 **(13) Helicopters.**
- 7 **(14) Mines.**
- 8 **(15) Roman candles.**
- 9 **(16) Sky rockets.**
- 10 **(17) Missile-type rockets.**
- 11 **(b) The state fire marshal may promulgate rules to restrict the**
- 12 **location at which a person may ignite, discharge, or use fireworks**
- 13 **described in subsection (a)."**
- 14 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
