MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 66 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, between lines 40 and 41, begin a new line block indented
- 2 and insert:
- 3 **"(2) the violation arose from an underground storage tank**
- 4 **that is in a cave (as defined in 329 IAC 10-2);**
- 5 **(3) the violation arose from an underground storage tank**
- 6 **that is in a sinkhole (as defined in 329 IAC 10-2);"**
- 7 Page 2, line 41, delete "(2)" and insert "(4)".
- 8 Page 3, line 1, delete "(3)" and insert "(5)".
- 9 Page 3, line 4, delete "(4)" and insert "(6)".
- 10 Page 3, between lines 9 and 10, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 11 **"SECTION 3. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) Before**
- 12 **February 1, 2000, the solid waste management board shall amend**
- 13 **329 IAC 10-2 to incorporate the following definitions of terms used**
- 14 **in IC 13-23-14-3 as amended by this act:**
- 15 **(1) "Cave" means a natural cavity in rock that is:**
- 16 **(A) large enough for a person to enter or greater than**
- 17 **twenty-four (24) cubic feet;**
- 18 **(B) laterally or vertically extensive or greater than**
- 19 **twenty-five (25) feet in length;**
- 20 **(C) formed by solution from current or past conduit**
- 21 **flow; and**
- 22 **(D) part of a natural subsurface conduit flow system.**
- 23 **The term refers to a landform feature that generally**
- 24 **develops in carbonate and evaporite rock regions (such as**
- 25 **limestone, dolomite, and gypsum) and is formed by solution**
- 26 **or a combination of solution and collapse.**
- 27 **(2) "Sinkhole" means a funnel shaped depression in the land**

1 **surface with:**
2 **(A) greater than three (3) feet of topographic relief; and**
3 **(B) a map surface area greater than one hundred (100)**
4 **square feet.**
5 **The depression provides active storm water drainage as part**
6 **of a subsurface conduit flow system developed by solution of**
7 **bedrock. The term refers to a landscape feature that**
8 **generally develops in carbonate and evaporite rock regions**
9 **(such as limestone, dolomite, and gypsum) and is formed by**
10 **solution or a combination of solution and collapse of**
11 **carbonate or interbedded carbonate and sedimentary**
12 **bedrock."**
13 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
14 Page 3, after line 23, begin a new paragraph and insert:
15 "SECTION 5. **An emergency is declared for this act.**"
