MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 158 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 4, between lines 19 and 20, begin a new paragraph and
2 insert:"SECTION 6. IC 9-26-1-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
3 CODE AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS**
4 **[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 1.5. A passenger in a vehicle**
5 **involved in an accident that results in the injury or death of a**
6 **person shall do the following:**
7 **(1) Remain at the scene of the accident in a manner that does**
8 **not obstruct traffic more than is necessary. Reasonable**
9 **efforts to obtain medical assistance for each person injured in**
10 **the accident complies with this requirement.**
11 **(2) Immediately give notice of the accident by the quickest**
12 **means of communication to one (1) of the following:**
13 **(A) The local police department if the accident occurs within**
14 **municipality.**
15 **(B) The office of the county sheriff or the nearest state police**
16 **post if the accident occurs outside a municipality.**
17 SECTION 7. IC 9-26-1-8.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
18 AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY**
19 **1, 1999]: Sec. 8.5 A person who fails to stop or comply with section**
20 **1.5 commits a Class B misdemeanor. However, the offense is a**
21 **Class A misdemeanor if the accident involves the death of a**
22 **person."**
