# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

**MR. SPEAKER:**

I move that House Bill 1001 be amended to read as follows:

- 1           Page 132, between lines 18 and 19, begin a new paragraph and
- 2           insert:
- 3           "SECTION 80. IC 7.1-1-2-13 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 4           FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 13. (a) The alcoholic
- 5           beverage commission shall categorize salaries of enforcement officers
- 6           within each rank based upon the rank held and the number of years of
- 7           service in the commission through the tenth year. The salary ranges
- 8           that the board assigns to each rank shall be divided into a base salary
- 9           and ten (10) increments above the base salary with:
- 10           (1) the base salary in the rank paid to a person with less than one
- 11           (1) year of service in the commission; and
- 12           (2) the highest salary in the rank paid to a person with at least ten
- 13           (10) years of service in the commission.
- 14           (b) For purposes of creating the salary matrix prescribed by this
- 15           section, the alcoholic beverage commission may not approve salary
- 16           ranges for any rank that are less than the salary ranges effective for that
- 17           rank on January 1, 1995.
- 18           (c) The salary matrix prescribed by this section shall be reviewed
- 19           and approved by the budget agency before implementation.
- 20           (d) The money needed to fund the salaries resulting from the
- 21           matrix prescribed by this section shall come from the amounts
- 22           appropriated from the professional and technical equity fund as
- 23           augmented by the budget agency from the state general fund.
- 24           (e) **The salary matrix prescribed by this section must have**
- 25           **parity with the salary matrices prescribed by the natural resources**
- 26           **commission under IC 14-9-8 for conservation officers of the**
- 27           **department of natural resources. The budget agency shall approve**

1 **a salary matrix that meets the parity requirement of this**  
2 **subsection."**

3 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
