# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

**MR. SPEAKER:**

I move that House Bill 1014 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, after line 14, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 2. IC 25-8-15-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 3 FOLLOWS: Sec. 9. (a) A cosmetology professional may apply in
- 4 writing to the board for a waiver or modification of the continuing
- 5 education requirements if the cosmetology professional:
- 6 (1) establishes that an emergency existed during the period for
- 7 which the continuing education was required;
- 8 (2) has had an incapacitating illness verified by the applicant and
- 9 a licensed physician;
- 10 (3) is licensed in another state that requires at least sixteen (16)
- 11 hours of continuing education, and the cosmetology professional
- 12 submits written verification to the board of compliance with the
- 13 requirements of the other state; ~~or~~
- 14 (4) was prevented from completing the continuing education
- 15 requirement because of active military duty during the period for
- 16 which the continuing education was required; **or**
- 17 **(5) provides cosmetology services no more than twelve (12)**
- 18 **hours per week.**
- 19 (b) **Except as provided in subsection (c), a** ~~A~~ waiver granted by
- 20 the board for an emergency, an illness, or military service of less than
- 21 one (1) year shall state that the continuing education requirement is
- 22 cumulative and that the required education must be completed and
- 23 satisfactory proof of completion must be filed with the board before the
- 24 license may be renewed. All other waivers must contain a continuing
- 25 education requirement as determined by the board on a waiver by
- 26 waiver basis and must state that the required education must be

1 completed and satisfactory proof of completion of the required  
2 education must be filed with the board before the license may be  
3 renewed.

4 **(c) A waiver granted for a person who provides cosmetology**  
5 **services no more than twelve (12) hours per week shall state that**  
6 **no continuing education is required."**
