HOUSE MOTION _____

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1639 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 3, between lines 32 and 33, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 2. IC 9-14-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 3 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 JULY 1, 1999]:
- 5 **Chapter 1.5 Bureau of Motor Vehicles Study Committee**
- 6 **Sec. 1. (a) As used in this chapter, "committee" refers to the**
- 7 **bureau of motor vehicles study committee established by**
- 8 **subsection (b).**
- 9 **(b) The bureau of motor vehicles study committee is**
- 10 **established to study the bureau of motor vehicles and the bureau**
- 11 **of motor vehicles commission.**
- 12 **Sec. 2. (a) The bureau of motor vehicles study committee shall**
- 13 **study:**
- 14 **(1) the bureau of motor vehicles;**
- 15 **(2) the bureau of motor vehicles commission; and**
- 16 **(3) other bureau of motor vehicles issues identified by the**
- 17 **committee as requiring study.**
- 18 **(b) The committee may study other topics assigned by the**
- 19 **legislative council or as directed by the committee chair.**
- 20 **Sec. 3. The committee consists of six (6) members appointed as**
- 21 **follows:**
- 22 **(1) Two (2) members of the senate, not more than one (1) of**
- 23 **whom may be affiliated with the same political party, to be**
- 24 **appointed by the president pro tempore of the senate.**
- 25 **(2) Two (2) members of the house of representatives, not**
- 26 **more than one (1) of whom may be affiliated with the same**
- 27 **political party, to be appointed by the speaker of the house**

1 of representatives.
2 (3) Two (2) individuals who are not members of the general
3 assembly, not more than one (1) of whom may be affiliated
4 with the same political party, to be appointed by the
5 governor.
6 Sec. 4. The governor shall appoint a member of the committee
7 to serve as chair of the committee, and a member of the committee
8 to serve as vice chair of the committee.
9 Sec. 5. (a) If a legislative member of the committee ceases to be
10 a member of the chamber from which the member was appointed,
11 the member also ceases to be a member of the committee.
12 (b) A member of the committee may be removed at any time
13 by the appointing authority who appointed the legislative member.
14 (c) If a vacancy exists on the committee, the appointing
15 authority who appointed the former member whose position is
16 vacant shall appoint an individual to fill the vacancy.
17 Sec. 6. (a) The committee shall submit an annual report of the
18 results of its study to the legislative council before June 30, 2000.
19 (b) The legislative services agency shall provide staff support
20 to the committee.
21 (c) The committee may employ consultants and experts to
22 assist with its study.
23 Sec. 7. Each member of the committee is entitled to receive the
24 same per diem, mileage, and travel allowances paid to individuals
25 who serve as legislative and lay members, respectively, of interim
26 study committees established by the legislative council.
27 Sec. 8. (a) A quorum of the committee consists of four (4)
28 members.
29 (b) The affirmative votes of a majority of the members
30 appointed to the committee are required for the committee to take
31 action on any measure, including final reports."
