MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 323 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, line 2, after "2.5." insert "(a)".
- 2 Page 1, line 12, delete "This subdivision", begin a new paragraph
- 3 and insert "**(b) The term**".
- 4 Page 1, line 14, delete "(A)" begin a new line block indented and
- 5 insert "**(1)**".
- 6 Page 2, line 1, delete "(i)" begin a new line double block indented
- 7 and insert "**(A)**".
- 8 Page 2, line 3, delete "(ii)" begin a new line double block indented
- 9 and insert "**(B)**".
- 10 Page 2, line 7, delete "(B)" begin a new line block indented and
- 11 insert "**(2)**".
- 12 Page 2, line 10, delete "." and insert "**and that becomes visible**
- 13 **within six (6) months after the first date of the damage by water.**".
- 14 Page 2, between lines 10 and 11, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 15 "SECTION 2. IC 9-22-3-7.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 16 AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY**
- 17 **1, 1999]: Sec. 7.5. (a) A dealer licensed as a dealer under IC 9-23 on**
- 18 **the date of receiving a title by sale or transfer shall secure an**
- 19 **affidavit from the person who holds the certificate of title. The**
- 20 **affidavit must state whether the vehicle is a flood damaged vehicle.**
- 21 **(b) The dealer shall file the affidavit with the bureau upon**
- 22 **receiving the title and shall retain a copy of the affidavit with the**
- 23 **records of the dealer.**

1 **(c) The bureau shall retain an affidavit regarding flood damage**
2 **to the vehicle submitted to the bureau by a dealer under this**
3 **section."**
