# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1920 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 9-14-3-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]:Sec. 5. (a) Except as
- 5 provided in subsection (b), (c), or (d), the bureau shall prepare and
- 6 deliver information on titles, registrations, and licenses and permits
- 7 upon the request of any person. All requests must be submitted in
- 8 writing to the bureau and, unless exempted under IC 9-29, must be
- 9 accompanied by the payment of the fee prescribed in IC 9-29-2-2.
- 10 (b) The bureau may not disclose the:
- 11 (1) Social Security number;
- 12 (2) federal identification number; ~~or~~
- 13 (3) driver's license number; **or**
- 14 **(4) digital image of the driver's license applicant:**
- 15 of any person except to a law enforcement officer or an agent or a
- 16 designee of the department of state revenue.
- 17 (c) As provided under 42 U.S.C. 1973gg-3(b), the commission
- 18 may not disclose any information concerning the failure of an applicant
- 19 for a motor vehicle driver's license to sign a voter registration
- 20 application, except as authorized under IC 3-7-14.
- 21 (d) The commission may not disclose any information concerning
- 22 the failure of an applicant for a title, registration, license, or permit
- 23 (other than a motor vehicle license described under subsection (c)) to
- 24 sign a voter registration application, except as authorized under

1 IC 3-7-14."

2 Page 2, line 5, delete "license:" and insert "license, a **chauffeur's**  
3 **license, a public passenger chauffeur's license, or a commercial**  
4 **driver's license**".

5 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
