MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 2035 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between lines 10 and 11, begin a new paragraph and
- 2 insert:
- 3 "SECTION 2. IC 16-18-2-295 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 295. (a) "Provider", for
- 5 purposes of IC 16-25, means a hospice program certified under
- 6 IC 16-25-1.
- 7 (b) "Provider", for purposes of **IC 16-38-5**, IC 16-39 (except for
- 8 IC 16-39-7), ~~and for purposes of IC 16-41-1 through IC 16-41-9, and~~
- 9 IC 16-41-37, means any of the following:
- 10 (1) An individual (other than an individual who is an employee
- 11 or a contractor of a hospital, a facility, or an agency described in
- 12 subdivision (2) or (3)) who is licensed, registered, or certified as
- 13 a health care professional, including the following:
- 14 (A) A physician.
- 15 (B) A psychotherapist.
- 16 (C) A dentist.
- 17 (D) A registered nurse.
- 18 (E) A licensed practical nurse.
- 19 (F) An optometrist.
- 20 (G) A podiatrist.
- 21 (H) A chiropractor.
- 22 (I) A physical therapist.
- 23 (J) A psychologist.
- 24 (K) An audiologist.

- 1 (L) A speech-language pathologist.
- 2 (M) A dietitian.
- 3 (N) An occupational therapist.
- 4 (O) A respiratory therapist.
- 5 (P) A pharmacist.
- 6 (2) A hospital or facility licensed under IC 16-21-2 or IC 12-25
- 7 or described in IC 12-24-1 or IC 12-29.
- 8 (3) A health facility licensed under IC 16-28-2.
- 9 (4) A home health agency licensed under IC 16-27-1.
- 10 (5) An employer of a certified emergency medical technician, a
- 11 certified advanced emergency medical technician, or a certified
- 12 paramedic.
- 13 **(6) The state department or a local health department or an**
- 14 **employee, agent, designee, or contractor of the state**
- 15 **department or local health department.**

16 (c) "Provider", for purposes of IC 16-39-7-1, has the meaning set
 17 forth in IC 16-39-7-1(a).

18 SECTION 3. IC 16-38-5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 19 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 20 JULY 1, 1999]: **Chapter 5. Immunization Data Registry**

21 **Sec. 1 The state department may develop an immunization**
 22 **data registry.**

23 **Sec. 2. A provider may provide immunization data to the**
 24 **immunization data registry without specific written authorization**
 25 **of the patient.**

26 **Sec. 3. (a) Records maintained as part of the immunization**
 27 **data registry are confidential.**

28 **(b) The state department may release confidential information**
 29 **concerning individual immunization patient records to the**
 30 **immunization data registry of another state or a provider if the**
 31 **following conditions are met:**

32 **(1) The other state registry or provider has entered into an**
 33 **agreement with the state department.**

34 **(2) The agreement provides that information that identifies**
 35 **a patient will not be released to any other person without the**
 36 **written consent of the patient."**

37 Page 3, line 8, after "(d)" insert ",".

38 Page 3, line 12, after "with" insert: "subsection".

39 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
