MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 31 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 12, between lines 29 and 30, begin a new paragraph and
- 2 insert:
- 3 "SECTION 18. IC 9-24-6-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 4 FOLLOWS: Sec. 2. (a) The bureau shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2
- 5 to regulate persons required to hold a commercial driver's license.
- 6 (b) The rules must carry out 49 U.S.C. 521, 49 U.S.C. ~~2304~~,
- 7 **31104**, 49 U.S.C. ~~2701~~**31301** through ~~2716~~ **31306**, **49 U.S.C.**
- 8 **31308 through 31316**, and 49 CFR 383.
- 9 (c) Rules adopted under this section must include the following:
- 10 (1) Establishment of classes and periods of validation of
- 11 commercial driver's licenses.
- 12 (2) Standards for commercial driver's licenses, including
- 13 suspension, **disqualification**, and revocation procedures.
- 14 (3) Development of written or oral tests, driving tests, and fitness
- 15 requirements.
- 16 (4) Defining the commercial driver's licenses by classification
- 17 and the information to be contained on the licenses, including
- 18 the Social Security number and a unique identifier of the holder.
- 19 (5) Establishing fees for the issuance of commercial driver's
- 20 licenses, including fees for testing and examination.
- 21 (6) Procedures for the notification by the holder of a commercial
- 22 driver's license to the bureau and the driver's employer of
- 23 pointable traffic offense convictions.
- 24 (7) The conditions for reciprocity with other states.
- 25 (8) Other rules necessary to administer this chapter.

1 (d) 49 CFR 383 is adopted as Indiana law.
2 SECTION 19. IC 9-24-6-11 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
3 FOLLOWS: Sec. 11. A driver who:
4 (1) is convicted of an offense described in section 8(5) of this
5 chapter; **or**
6 (2) **has been found to have used a controlled substance**
7 **indicated by post-accident testing conducted under 49 U.S.C.**
8 **31306 in Indiana or any other state or province;**
9 is disqualified for life from driving a commercial motor vehicle."
Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
