MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 84 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert the
 - 2 following:
 - 3 "SECTION 1. IC 27-1-22-27 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
 - 4 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
 - 5 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: **Sec. 27 (a) The purpose of this section**
 - 6 **is to preclude insurers from charging higher rates for innocent**
 - 7 **prior-uninsured motorists who have not operated a motor vehicle**
 - 8 **in violation of any financial responsibility or compulsory insurance**
 - 9 **requirement within the prior twelve months.**
 - 10 (b) As used in this section, "motor vehicle insurance" means
 - 11 any type of insurance described in IC 27-1-5-1, Class 2(f).
 - 12 (c) A motor vehicle insurer may not discriminate in
 - 13 establishing a rate for a policyholder or applicant, based solely on
 - 14 the absence of insurance by the applicant or policyholder.
 - 15 (d) This section does not apply to applicants who first received
 - 16 their driver's license within the past thirty-six (36) month period.
 - 17 (e) A violation of this section is an unfair and deceptive act or
 - 18 practice in the business of insurance under IC 27-4-1-4."
