MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 605 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 23, between lines 37 and 38, begin a new paragraph and
- 2 insert:
- 3 "SECTION 21. IC 25-13-1-10 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 4 FOLLOWS: Sec. 10. (a) A licensed dental hygienist may be employed
- 5 to practice dental hygiene in Indiana in the following:
- 6 (1) The office of a legally practicing proprietor dentist.
- 7 (2) A dental school or dental hygiene school to teach and
- 8 demonstrate the practice of dental hygiene.
- 9 (3) The dental clinic of any public, parochial, or private school
- 10 or other institution supported by public or private funds in which
- 11 the licensee is employed by the state department of health or any
- 12 county or city board of health or board of education or school
- 13 trustee or parochial authority or the governing body of any
- 14 private school. However, institutional practice, other than dental
- 15 hygiene instruction and dental prophylaxis for children up to and
- 16 including grade 12 pupils at all times must be under the
- 17 supervision of a licensed dentist.
- 18 (4) The dental clinic of a bona fide hospital, sanitarium, or
- 19 eleemosynary institution duly established and being operated
- 20 under the laws of Indiana in which the licensee is employed by
- 21 the directors or governing board of such hospital, sanitarium, or
- 22 institution. However, such practice must be under the
- 23 supervision at all times of a licensed dentist who is a staff
- 24 member of the hospital or sanitarium or a member of the
- 25 governing board of the institution.

- 1 (5) The dental clinic of an industrial or a commercial
2 establishment in which the licensee's services are under the
3 supervision of a licensed dentist.
- 4 (b) A licensed dental hygienist may provide without supervision
5 the following:
- 6 (1) Dental hygiene instruction and in-service training without
7 restriction on location.
- 8 (2) Dental prophylaxis **and sealants** for children up to and
9 including grade 12 if the dental hygienist is employed by any of
10 the following:
- 11 (A) The state department of health.
- 12 (B) The department of education.
- 13 (C) The elementary or secondary school where the services
14 are provided.
- 15 **(D) A provider in the children's health insurance**
16 **program.**
- 17 (3) Screening and referrals for any person in a public health
18 setting.
- 19 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
