HOUSE BILL No. 1101

DIGEST OF HB 1101 (Updated February 22, 1999 5:27 pm - DI 71)

Citations Affected: IC 9-18.

Synopsis: Boys and girls clubs license plates. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to design and issue a special group recognition license plate for the Indiana Boys and Girls Clubs. Provides that a person who is eligible to register a vehicle may obtain an Indiana Boys and Girls Clubs license plate upon completing an application and paying an appropriate fee.

Effective: January 1, 2000.

HOUSE BILL No. 1101

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-18-15-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2000]: Sec. 1. (a) A person
3 who is the registered owner or lessee of a:
4 (1) passenger motor vehicle;
5 (2) motorcycle;
6 (3) recreational vehicle; or
7 (4) vehicle registered as a truck with a declared gross weight of

9 (A) eleven thousand (11,000) pounds;
10 (B) nine thousand (9,000) pounds; or
11 (C) seven thousand (7,000) pounds;
12 registered with the bureau or who makes an application for an original
13 registration or renewal registration of a vehicle may apply to the bureau
14 for a personalized license plate to be affixed to the vehicle for which
15 registration is sought instead of the regular license plate.
