HOUSE BILL No. 1230

DIGEST OF HB1230 (Updated February 2, 1999 1:15 pm - DI 97)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Mutual insurance company study. Establishes a two year interim committee to study mutual insurance companies. Provides that the committee consists of eight members of the general assembly appointed by the speaker of the house and the president pro tempore of the senate. Requires the committee to conduct meetings and to issue a final report of its findings and recommendations to the legislative council not later than November 1, 2000. Provides that the committee is under the jurisdiction of the legislative council. Requires the legislative services agency to provide staff and administrative support for the committee.

HOUSE BILL No. 1230

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE MAY 15, 1999] (a) **The mutual**
2 **insurance company study committee (referred to as "the**
3 **committee" in this SECTION) is established.**

4 (b) **The committee shall study the law concerning mutual**
5 **insurance companies and proposals to change that law. The**
6 **committee may study other topics:**

7 (1) **as assigned by the legislative council; or**

8 (2) **as directed by the chairman of the committee.**

9 (c) **The committee consists of eight (8) members of the general**
10 **assembly, appointed as follows:**

11 (1) **The speaker of the house of representatives, with the**
12 **advice of the minority leader of the house of representatives,**
13 **shall appoint four (4) members of the house of**
14 **representatives, not more than two (2) of whom are members**
15 **of the same political party.**

16 (2) **The president pro tempore of the senate, with the advice**
17 **of the minority leader of the senate, shall appoint four (4)**
18 **members of the senate, not more than two (2) of whom are**

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- 1 members of the same political party.
- 2 (d) At the time the committee members are appointed in 1999,
3 the speaker of the house of representatives shall name one (1) of
4 the members chairman and the president pro tempore shall name
5 another member vice chairman. The terms of the chairman and
6 vice chairman appointed under this subsection begin June 1, 1999,
7 and terminate March 15, 2000.
- 8 (e) After January 1, 2000, the president pro tempore shall name
9 one (1) of the members chairman and the speaker shall name
10 another member vice chairman. The terms of the chairman and
11 vice chairman appointed under this subsection begin March 16,
12 2000, and terminate December 1, 2000.
- 13 (f) The initial appointments to the committee shall be made
14 before June 1, 1999. The appointments are for a term expiring
15 December 1, 2000. A vacancy shall be filled through the
16 appointment of a replacement by the appointing authority.
- 17 (g) To carry out its duties under this SECTION, the committee
18 shall do the following:
- 19 (1) Conduct meetings to hear the concerns of citizens of
20 Indiana and obtain advice from interested professionals.
- 21 (2) Issue a final report of its findings and recommendations to
22 the legislative council not later than November 1, 2000.
- 23 (h) The committee shall meet at the call of the chairman.
- 24 (i) Each member of the committee is entitled to receive the same
25 per diem, mileage, and travel allowance paid to members of the
26 general assembly serving on interim study committees established
27 by the legislative council.
- 28 (j) The committee is under the jurisdiction of the legislative
29 council and shall operate under policies and procedures established
30 by the legislative council.
- 31 (k) The affirmative votes of a majority of the members
32 appointed to the committee are required for the committee to take
33 action on any measure, including final reports.
- 34 (l) The legislative services agency shall provide staff and
35 administrative support for the committee.
- 36 (m) This SECTION expires December 1, 2000.
- 37 SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
