DIGEST OF HB 1252 (Updated January 21, 1999 2:43 pm - DI 96)

Citations Affected: IC 20-12.

Synopsis: Ball State teaching contractor benefits. Requires Ball State University to provide the same health insurance benefits to individuals who teach under a contract with the university as the university provides to its employees, provided that the individuals have taught the length of time required for an employee of the university to become eligible for retirement health benefits.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

HOUSE BILL No. 1252

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-12-57.5-11 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 11. ~~(Board: Body~~
3 ~~Corporate; Powers)~~ The board of trustees shall constitute a perpetual
4 body corporate with power to:
5 (a) (1) manage, control and operate Ball State University;
6 (b) (2) sue and be sued;
7 (c) (3) let contracts;
8 (d) (4) borrow money and issue bonds as authorized by the
9 Indiana General Assembly;
10 (e) (5) prescribe conditions for admission;
11 (f) (6) grant degrees and issue diplomas or certificates;
12 (g) (7) fix laboratory, contingent, and other fees and charges;
13 (h) (8) set fines and penalties;
14 (i) (9) **subject to section 12 of this chapter**, define the duties and
15 provide compensation for faculty and staff of the university,
16 including authority to establish fringe benefit programs including
17 retirement benefits which may be supplemental to, or in lieu of,

- 1 state retirement programs for teachers or other public employees

 3 ~~(j)~~ **(10)** receive and administer all donations, bequests, grants,
 4 funds, and property which are given to or provided for the

 7 ~~(l)~~ **(12)** exercise all powers, rights, privileges, and duties
 8 conferred upon the board by other laws of the general assembly;

 10 ~~(m)~~ **(13)** to possess all other power in order to efficiently operate

12 SECTION 2. IC 20-12-57.5-12 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
 13 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
 14 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: **Sec. 12. (a) This section applies to an**
 15 **individual who:**

- 16 **(1) has entered into a contract with Ball State University to**
 17 **provide teaching services for the university;**
 18 **(2) was a contract employee of Ball State University while**
 19 **providing the services described in subdivision (1); and**
 20 **(3) provided the services described in subdivision (1):**
 21 **(A) before January 1, 1999; and**
 22 **(B) for the length of time required for an employee of the**
 23 **university described in subsection (b)(1) to become eligible**
 24 **for retirement health insurance benefits.**
 25 **(b) The Ball State University board of trustees shall provide an**
 26 **individual described in subsection (a) with health insurance**
 27 **benefits:**
 28 **(1) that are identical to the retirement health insurance**
 29 **benefits of an employee of the university who holds a position**
 30 **similar to that of the individual; and**
 31 **(2) at the same cost to the individual as that paid by a retired**
 32 **employee of the university.**

Page 2, line 17, delete "or other".

Page 2, line 17, delete "and".

Page 2, line 18, delete "is not an" and insert "**was a contract**".

Page 2, line 18, delete "." and insert "**while providing the services described in subdivision (1); and**".

Page 2, between lines 18 and 19, begin a new line block indented and insert:

"(3) provided the services described in subdivision (1):

(A) before January 1, 1999; and

(B) for the length of time required for an employee of the university described in subsection (b)(1) to become eligible for retirement health insurance benefits."

Page 2, line 22, after "to the" insert "**retirement health insurance**".

Page 2, line 25, delete "an" and insert "**a retired**".
