Citations Affected: IC 14-8; IC 14-23.

Synopsis: Indiana rural fire protection initiative. Establishes the Indiana rural fire protection initiative (INRFPI) to provide assistance to rural fire departments and complement grant programs established by the United States government for assisting rural fire departments. Provides for administration of the program by the department of natural resources.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

2 **Chapter 6.5. Indiana Rural Fire Protection Initiative (INRFPI)**
3 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "program" refers to the Indiana**

18 **(3) Assistance to rural fire departments in meeting safety and**

20 **Indiana and United States governments.**
21 **Sec. 6. The program must complement grant programs**
22 **established by the United States government for the program.**
23 **Sec. 7. The department shall do the following:**
24 **(1) Administer the program.**
25 **(2) Administer grants provided by the United States**
26 **government for the program.**
