DIGEST OF HB 1510 (Updated February 24, 1999 3:00 pm - DI 98)

Citations Affected: IC 14-8; IC 14-21.

Synopsis: Family heritage certificate. Provides that the division of historic preservation and archeology of the department of natural resources shall issue commemorative family heritage certificates reflecting specific time periods for settlement in the state. Establishes a fee for issuance with part of the fee to offset costs and the remainder of the fee for deposit in a historic preservation fund. Establishes the historic preservation fund for use of the division of historic preservation and archeology of the department of natural resources.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

7 **1, 1999]: Sec. 6.5. As used in this chapter, "fund" refers to the**
8 **historic preservation fund established by section 32 of this chapter.**

9 SECTION 3. IC 14-21-1-32 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
10 AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY**
11 **1, 1999]: Sec. 32. (a) The historic preservation fund is established**
12 **to carry out the purposes of this chapter that relate to historic**
13 **preservation. The department shall administer the fund.**

14 **(b) The following shall be deposited in the fund:**

15 **(1) The money specified in IC 14-21-2-8 that is collected from**
16 **the sale of family heritage certificates.**

17 **(2) Gifts of money to the fund or the proceeds from the sale of**
18 **gifts donated to the fund.**

19 **(c) Money in the fund must be used to supplement and not to**
20 **replace state general fund appropriations to the department.**

21 **(d) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not**
22 **revert to the state general fund. However, if the fund is abolished,**
23 **the money in the fund reverts to the state general fund.**

24 SECTION 4. IC 14-21-2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
25 A **NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY**
26 **1, 1999]:**

27 **Chapter 2. Family Heritage Certificates**

28 **Sec. 1. The division shall design, promote, and sell family**

COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Speaker: Your Committee on Human Affairs, to which was referred House Bill 1510, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

Page 3, line 15, delete "IC 16-37-1-11.7(d)(2)(B)" and insert "**IC 14-21-2-8**".

Page 3, line 16, after "of" insert "**family**".

Page 3, line 16, delete "birth".

Page 3, delete lines 24 through 42, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 4. IC 14-21-2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]:

Chapter 2. Family Heritage Certificates

Sec. 1. The division shall design, promote, and sell family heritage certificates.

Sec. 2. A family heritage certificate must:

- (1) be specially designed for framing and display;
- (2) contain a background design, an emblem, or colors that designate the certificate as a family heritage certificate; and
- (3) contain any other information that the division considers necessary.

Sec. 3. A family heritage certificate must be offered for the following:

- (1) Pioneer family, for a person whose family settled in Indiana through 1816.
- (2) Early settler, for a person whose family settled in Indiana from 1817 through 1865.
- (3) Post-civil war settler, for a person whose family settled in Indiana from 1866 through 1890.
- (4) Victorian era settler, for a person whose family settled in Indiana from 1891 through 1910.

Sec. 4. A family heritage certificate may be issued only upon the presentation of genealogical findings showing that the person named on the certificate has the appropriate heritage for which a family heritage certificate is sought.

Sec. 5. A family heritage certificate commemorates but is not proof that the person named on the certificate has the heritage for which a family heritage certificate is issued.

Sec. 6. The division shall charge a fee of thirty dollars (\$30) for a family heritage certificate.

Sec. 7. The division may retain a portion of the fee collected under section 6 of this chapter to offset the cost of the family heritage certificate.

Sec. 8. The division shall deposit the fee collected under section 6 of this chapter, less any amount retained under section 7 of this chapter, into the historic preservation fund established by IC 14-21-1-32.

Sec. 9. The division may contract with an independent contractor to perform the duties of the division under this chapter."
