Citations Affected: IC 20-12.

Synopsis: Audits of Riley Hospital. Provides that an Indiana public interest nonprofit corporation to which the board of trustees of Indiana University, with the approval of the governor, delegates authority to manage and operate the James Whitcomb Riley Hospital for Children is not subject to an audit by the state board of accounts.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

PRINTING CODE. Amendments: Whenever an existing statute (or a section of the Indiana Constitution) is being amended, the text of the existing provision will appear in this style type, additions will appear in **this style type**, and deletions will appear in ~~this style type~~.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 1998 General Assembly.

HOUSE BILL No. 1774

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-12-31.5-6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: **Sec. 6. An Indiana public interest**
4 **nonprofit corporation to which the board of trustees of Indiana**
5 **University, with the approval of the governor, delegates authority**
6 **to manage and operate the James Whitcomb Riley Hospital for**
7 **Children is not subject to an audit by the state board of accounts,**
8 **notwithstanding IC 5-11-1-9. However, Indiana University is**
9 **subject to an audit by the state board of accounts.**
