



**CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT
DIGEST FOR SB 204**

Citations Affected: IC 2-5; IC 4-13.6; IC 5.

Synopsis: Internet notice of state meetings and bid lists. Requires state agencies to provide electronic access to notices of public meetings and invitations to bid on contracts for public works and supplies. Provides that an electronic geographic information system that is produced from data gathered by the legislative services agency and processed using proprietary software is the work product of the legislative services agency for purposes of the public records law. (This conference committee report: (1) deletes SECTIONS 3 and 8 concerning guaranteed energy savings and energy efficiency loans; and (2) clarifies the application of the provision concerning electronic geographic information systems produced by the legislative services agency.)

Effective: Upon passage; July 1, 1999.
