MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Local Government, to which was referred Senate Bill 347, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert the following:
- 2 SECTION 1. IC 5-2-5-14 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 3 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 14. (a) Criminal history data on an**
- 5 **individual from the national computerized file may be made**
- 6 **available outside the federal government to state and local public**
- 7 **safety agencies for public safety agency employment purposes.**
- 8 **(b) Criminal history data may not be disseminated for use in**
- 9 **connection with:**
- 10 **(1) licensing applications, except when a federal, state, or local**
- 11 **law or ordinance exists making the criminal justice agency**
- 12 **responsible for the processing or issuing of the licenses or**
- 13 **permits;**
- 14 **(2) local or state employment, other than with a public safety**

1 **agency; or**
2 **(2) any other use;**
3 **unless the dissemination is required by a state or federal statute or**
4 **a state or federal executive order.**
5 **(c) This section applies not withstanding any other law.**
6 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] **Before December**
7 **31, 1999, the commission shall amend 240 IAC 5-2-10 to delete 240**
8 **IAC 5-2-10(h)(1) concerning the procedures for the use of**
9 **system-derived criminal history data.**
10 SECTION 3. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
 (Reference is to SB 347 as printed January 29, 1999.)
