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# COMMITTEE REPORT

**MR. SPEAKER:**

*Your Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred House Bill 1192, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

1           Page 2, after line 19, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
2           "SECTION 2. IC 33-2.1-12-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
3           FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 7. Beginning July 1,  
4           1999, and every year thereafter, there is appropriated from the state  
5           general fund to the office of judicial administration, division of state  
6           court administration, five hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$550,000), to  
7           be used for the Indiana conference for legal education opportunity  
8           established by this chapter. **Supplemental to the amount specified in**  
9           **this section, the general assembly may appropriate additional**  
10          **funds to the Indiana conference for legal education opportunity.**  
11          SECTION 3. IC 33-4-8-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
12          [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 5. (a) A senior judge is entitled to:  
13          (1) **the greater of:**

- 1           (A) a per diem of fifty dollars (\$50); **or**  
 2           **(B) a per diem set by appropriation;** and  
 3       (2) reimbursement for:  
 4           (A) mileage; and  
 5           (B) reasonable expenses, including but not limited to meals  
 6           and lodging, incurred in performing service as a senior judge;  
 7       for each day served as a senior judge.  
 8       (b) The per diem and reimbursement for mileage and reasonable  
 9       expenses under subsection (a) shall be paid by the state.  
 10       (c) A senior judge appointed under this chapter may not be  
 11       compensated as a senior judge for more than one hundred (100)  
 12       calendar days in the aggregate during a calendar year.  
 13       SECTION 4. IC 33-19-7-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
 14       FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 5. (a) On June 30 and  
 15       on December 31 of each year, the auditor of state shall transfer to the  
 16       treasurer of state six million seven hundred four thousand two hundred  
 17       fifty-seven dollars (\$6,704,257) for distribution under subsection (b).  
 18       (b) On June 30 and on December 31 of each year the treasurer of  
 19       state shall deposit into:  
 20           (1) the family violence and victim assistance fund established  
 21           under IC 12-18-5-2 an amount equal to eleven and  
 22           eight-hundredths percent (11.08%);  
 23           (2) the Indiana judges' retirement fund established under  
 24           IC 33-13-8 an amount equal to twenty-five and twenty-one  
 25           hundredths percent (25.21%);  
 26           (3) the law enforcement academy building fund established under  
 27           IC 5-2-1-13 an amount equal to three and fifty-two hundredths  
 28           percent (3.52%);  
 29           (4) the law enforcement training fund established under  
 30           IC 5-2-1-13 an amount equal to fourteen and nineteen-hundredths  
 31           percent (14.19%);  
 32           (5) the violent crime victims compensation fund established under  
 33           IC 5-2-6.1-40 an amount equal to sixteen and fifty-hundredths  
 34           percent (16.50%);  
 35           (6) the motor vehicle highway account an amount equal to  
 36           twenty-six and ninety-five hundredths percent (26.95%);  
 37           (7) the fish and wildlife fund established by IC 14-22-3-2 an  
 38           amount equal to thirty-two hundredths of one percent (0.32%);

1           and  
2           (8) the Indiana judicial center drug and alcohol programs fund  
3           established under IC 12-23-14-17 for the administration,  
4           certification, and support of alcohol and drug services programs  
5           under IC 12-23-14 an amount equal to two and twenty-three  
6           hundredths percent (2.23%);  
7           of the amount transferred by the auditor of state under subsection (a).  
8           (c) On June 30 and on December 31 of each year the auditor of state  
9           shall transfer to the treasurer of state one million two hundred thousand  
10          dollars (\$1,200,000) for deposit into the public defense fund  
11          established under IC 33-9-14. **Supplemental to the amount specified**  
12          **in this subsection, the general assembly may appropriate additional**  
13          **funds to the public defense fund."**  
            (Reference is to HB 1192 as introduced.)
