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# COMMITTEE REPORT

**MR. SPEAKER:**

*Your Committee on Public Policy, Ethics and Veterans Affairs, to which was referred Senate Bill 55, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1           Page 3, between lines 40 and 41, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2           "SECTION 3. IC 7.1-3-18-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 3           FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 9. (a) The
- 4           commission may issue an employee's permit to a person who desires to
- 5           act as a clerk in a package liquor store or as a bartender, waiter,
- 6           waitress, or manager in a retail establishment, excepting dining car and
- 7           boat employees.
- 8           (b) A permit authorized by this section is conditioned upon the
- 9           compliance by the holder with reasonable rules relating to the permit
- 10          which the commission may prescribe from time to time.
- 11          (c) A permit issued under this section entitles its holder to work for
- 12          any lawful employer. However, a person may work without an
- 13          employee's permit for thirty (30) days from the date shown on a receipt
- 14          for a cashier's check or money order payable to the commission for that

- 1 person's employee's permit application.
- 2 (d) A person who, for a package liquor store or retail establishment,
- 3 is:
- 4 (1) the sole proprietor;
- 5 (2) a partner, a general partner, or a limited partner in a
- 6 partnership or limited partnership that owns the business
- 7 establishment;
- 8 (3) a member of a limited liability company that owns the
- 9 business establishment; or
- 10 (4) a stockholder in a corporation that owns the business
- 11 establishment;

12 is not required to obtain an employee's permit in order to perform any

13 of the acts listed in subsection (a).

14 **(e) An applicant may declare on the application form that the**

15 **applicant will use the employee's permit only to perform volunteer**

16 **service that benefits a nonprofit organization. It is unlawful for an**

17 **applicant who makes a declaration under this subsection to use an**

18 **employee's permit for any purpose other than to perform volunteer**

19 **service that benefits a nonprofit organization.**

20 SECTION 4. IC 7.1-4-1-38 IS AMENDED TO READ AS

21 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 38. (a) The

22 biennial license fee for an employee's permit is:

- 23 (1) twenty dollars (\$20); or
- 24 (2) five dollars (\$5) if the permit is used only to perform
- 25 volunteer service that benefits a nonprofit organization. and
- 26 (b) The term of the permit is two (2) years."

27 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.  
 (Reference is to SB 55 as printed February 9, 1999.)
