MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Human Affairs, to which was referred House Bill 1510, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 3, line 15, delete "IC 16-37-1-11.7(d)(2)(B)" and insert "**IC**
- 2 **14-21-2-8**".
- 3 Page 3, line 16, after "of" insert "**family**".
- 4 Page 3, line 16, delete "birth".
- 5 Page 3, delete lines 24 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
- 6 insert:
- 7 "SECTION 4. IC 14-21-2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 8 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 9 JULY 1, 1999]:
- 10 **Chapter 2. Family Heritage Certificates**
- 11 **Sec. 1. The division shall design, promote, and sell family**
- 12 **heritage certificates.**
- 13 **Sec. 2. A family heritage certificate must:**
- 14 **(1) be specially designed for framing and display;**

- 1 **(2) contain a background design, an emblem, or colors that**
- 2 **designate the certificate as a family heritage certificate; and**
- 3 **(3) contain any other information that the division considers**
- 4 **necessary.**

5 **Sec. 3. A family heritage certificate must be offered for the**
6 **following:**

7 **(1) Pioneer family, for a person whose family settled in**
8 **Indiana through 1816.**

9 **(2) Early settler, for a person whose family settled in Indiana**
10 **from 1817 through 1865.**

11 **(3) Post-civil war settler, for a person whose family settled in**
12 **Indiana from 1866 through 1890.**

13 **(4) Victorian era settler, for a person whose family settled in**
14 **Indiana from 1891 through 1910.**

15 **Sec. 4. A family heritage certificate may be issued only upon the**
16 **presentation of genealogical findings showing that the person**
17 **named on the certificate has the appropriate heritage for which a**
18 **family heritage certificate is sought.**

19 **Sec. 5. A family heritage certificate commemorates but is not**
20 **proof that the person named on the certificate has the heritage for**
21 **which a family heritage certificate is issued.**

22 **Sec. 6. The division shall charge a fee of thirty dollars (\$30) for**
23 **a family heritage certificate.**

24 **Sec. 7. The division may retain a portion of the fee collected**
25 **under section 6 of this chapter to offset the cost of the family**
26 **heritage certificate.**

27 **Sec. 8. The division shall deposit the fee collected under section**
28 **6 of this chapter, less any amount retained under section 7 of this**
29 **chapter, into the historic preservation fund established by**
30 **IC 14-21-1-32.**

31 **Sec. 9. The division may contract with an independent**
32 **contractor to perform the duties of the division under this**
