*Your Committee on Environmental Affairs, to which was referred Senate Bill 513, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 2, line 15, delete the effective date "[EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
- 2 1999]" and insert the effective date "[EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1999
- 3 (RETROACTIVE)]:".
- 4 Page 3, delete lines 37 through 42, begin a new line double block
- 5 indented and insert:
- 6 **"(B) after January 1, 1999, the district may not adopt a**
- 7 **resolution or continue to enforce a resolution or an**
- 8 **ordinance that establishes permits or licenses for:**
- 9 **(i) the siting or operation of a solid waste management**
- 10 **facility that is not owned by the district; or**
- 11 **(ii) the collection and transportation of solid waste;**
- 12 **if the siting or operation of the facility or the collection and**
- 13 **transportation of the solid waste is regulated under a**
- 14 **federal, state, or local statute or ordinance or is otherwise**
- 15 **regulated by another governmental entity."**
- 16 Page 7, delete lines 4 through 9, begin a new line double block

1 indented and insert:

2 **"(B) after January 1, 1999, the district may not adopt a**
3 **resolution or continue to enforce a resolution or an**
4 **ordinance that establishes permits or licenses for:**

5 **(i) the siting or operation of a solid waste management**
6 **facility that is not owned by the district; or**

7 **(ii) the collection and transportation of solid waste;**
8 **if the siting or operation of the facility or the collection and**
9 **transportation of the solid waste is regulated under a**
10 **federal, state, or local statute or ordinance or is otherwise**
11 **regulated by another governmental entity."**

12 Page 10, after line 30, begin a new paragraph and insert:

13 **"SECTION 6. An emergency is declared for this act."**
