*Your Committee on Courts and Criminal Code, to which was referred Senate Bill 525, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 1, delete lines 1 through 5.
- 2 Page 1, line 6, delete "1." and insert "2."
- 3 Page 2, delete lines 10 through 42.
- 4 Delete pages 3 through 4.
- 5 Page 5, delete lines 1 through 4.
- 6 Page 5, line 5, delete "2." and insert "4."
- 7 Page 5, line 34, delete "successfully complete an alcohol or a" and
- 8 insert "**receive an assessment of the person's degree of alcohol and**
- 9 **drug abuse and, if appropriate, to undergo alcohol or drug abuse**
- 10 **treatment;**".
- 11 Page 5, delete line 35.
- 12 Page 6, line 7, delete "successfully complete an alcohol or a" and
- 13 insert "**receive an assessment of the person's degree of alcohol and**
- 14 **drug abuse and, if appropriate, to undergo alcohol or drug abuse**
- 15 **treatment;**".
- 16 Page 6, delete line 8.

- 1 Page 6, delete lines 23 through 42.
- 2 Delete pages 7 through 10, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 4. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] **The legislative**
- 4 **council shall provide in 1999 for a review by an appropriate study**
- 5 **committee of the open container provisions in IC 9-30-15-3 to**
- 6 **determine what revisions, if any, are needed to protect public**
- 7 **safety and comply with federal mandates related to the distribution**
- 8 **of federal transportation money.**
- 9 SECTION 5. **An emergency is declared for this act."**
- 10 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
