### MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Environmental Affairs, to which was referred House Bill 2076, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 1, line 9, delete "the".
- 2 Page 1, line 10, before "county" insert "the".
- 3 Page 1, line 11, after "(B)" insert "**subject to subsection (d), the**".
- 4 Page 2, line 1, delete "reasonable attorney's fees" and insert ":".
- 5 Page 2, delete line 2, begin a new line block indented and insert:
- 6 " **(1)** reasonable attorney's fees **and court costs** incurred in
- 7 bringing the action; **and**
- 8 **(2)** reasonable cleanup costs incurred by the county, city,
- 9 town, or solid waste management district to remove and
- 10 appropriately dispose of the unlawfully dumped solid waste
- 11 subject to IC 13-30-3-13.

1           **(d) A solid waste management district may bring a civil action**  
2           **under this chapter only to abate or enjoin a nuisance caused by the**  
3           **unlawful dumping of solid waste."**

(Reference is to HB 2076 as introduced.)
