

First Regular Session 111th General Assembly (1999)

PRINTING CODE. Amendments: Whenever an existing statute (or a section of the Indiana Constitution) is being amended, the text of the existing provision will appear in this style type, additions will appear in **this style type**, and deletions will appear in ~~this style type~~.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 1998 General Assembly.

HOUSE ENROLLED ACT No. 1604

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 14-16-2-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 7. (a) The owner of each snowmobile required to be registered under this chapter must do the following:

- (1) File an application for registration with the department on forms provided by the department.
- (2) Sign the application.
- (3) Pay a fee of ~~fifteen dollars (\$15)~~; **thirty dollars (\$30)**.

(b) Upon receipt of an application in approved form, the department shall enter the application upon the department's records and issue to the applicant the following:

- (1) A certificate of registration containing the following:
 - (A) The number awarded to the snowmobile.
 - (B) The name and address of the owner.
 - (C) Other information that the department considers necessary.
- (2) Two (2) decals indicating the year of expiration that shall be attached to the snowmobile as provided in section 12 of this chapter.
- (c) A certificate of registration must:

- (1) be pocket size;
- (2) accompany the snowmobile; and
- (3) be made available for inspection upon demand by a law enforcement officer.

(d) A person may not alter in any manner a certificate of registration issued by the department.

SECTION 2. IC 14-16-2-27 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 27. (a) The department shall do the following:

- (1) Prescribe the form of accident reports and registration certificates and the form of application for the certificates.
- (2) Conduct a campaign of education with respect to safety in the operation of snowmobiles in connection with the use and enjoyment of the public and private land of Indiana and with respect to Indiana laws relating to snowmobiles.
- (3) Construct and maintain snowmobile trails on public and private land consistent with the intent of this chapter.

(b) Notwithstanding any other law, the department may purchase land for snowmobile trails only from a willing seller of the land.
