HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring Treasurer of State Joyce Brinkman.

Whereas, Joyce Brinkman has been combining public and private service and making it her way of life for over 25 years;

Whereas, Joyce began her political career as a volunteer in New Augusta, Indiana;

Whereas, Joyce received her bachelor of arts degree in history from Hanover College and performed her graduate work in public administration at IUPUI;

Whereas, Joyce has served the state of Indiana in various capacities including Vice Precinct Committeeman, Precinct Committeeman, City-County Councilor, House of Representatives member from District 48, and finally as Treasurer of State;

Whereas, While serving as Treasurer of State, Joyce has given Indiana a written investment policy that has been certified by a national organization for the first time in the history of the state;

Whereas, While serving for nine years in the House of Representatives, Joyce served on the Committee on Financial Institutions, the Ways and Means Committee, the Governmental Affairs Committee, the Insurance and Corporations Committee, the Elections and Apportionment



Committee, and the Courts and Criminal Code Committee, among others;

Whereas, For her outstanding work in the health care field, Joyce was awarded the annual Family Health Advocate Award from the Indiana State Board of Health;

Whereas, Joyce has also received the 1988 Legislative Leadership Award from the Indiana Council of Churches and the Senator Charles Bosma Legislator of the Year Award in 1989 from the Indiana Public Health Association;

Whereas, In May 1997, Joyce was named a Henry Toll Fellow by the Council of State Governments, a distinction that is only given to 40 emerging leaders from across the country each year;

Whereas, She is currently serving as the treasurer of the national Association of State Treasurers (NAST) and was elected by her peers in NAST to the executive board of the College Savings Plans Network;

Whereas, Joyce is also a member of the Council of State Governments' Intergovernmental Affairs and Strategic Planning Committees;

Whereas, Joyce was one of the first state treasurers in the country to attend the NAST National Institute for Public Finance at the University of Delaware;

Whereas, Joyce is married to retired Howard County Judge Carl Van Dorn and has two grown children, Shane and Muffett; and

Whereas, Joyce Brinkman has served her state loyally for 25 years. Her contributions have improved the lives of all citizens of Indiana and helped to make Indiana one of the best states in which to live: Therefore,
