HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring the veterans of the Vietnam War.

Whereas, The war in Vietnam was our nation's longest war;

Whereas, 1,531 men and women from Indiana were killed in action during the war in Vietnam;

Whereas, There are still 66 Hoosiers listed as either prisoners of war or missing in action from this conflict;

Whereas, The state of Indiana hosts two of the largest and oldest Vietnam Veterans Reunions in America; and

Whereas, The veterans of the war in Vietnam fought in an unpopular war and have become our country's unknown veterans, often receiving very little respect for the sacrifices they have made for their country;

Whereas, When the veterans returned home, they often did not receive the welcome they deserved;

Whereas, The Vietnam veterans deserve our respect and admiration for the duties they performed during the war in Vietnam;

Whereas, Since America has relied upon her veterans in times of war to protect our way of life, it only seems just and proper that America honor the veterans of all her wars,



including the war in Vietnam: Therefore,
